ReedI overlooked this book for a long time because I thought it was one of those beginner easy to make simple doll books, and might confused it with a similar title. I think this book would do best for someone who has done basic sewing for awhile and is ready to make something more refined than a simple rag doll. Advanced crafters will find lots of patterns and ideas to expand on.If you're familiar with the Susan Sirkus Wishbooks and/or The Doll Book by Worrel then you'll have a good idea what this book is about. The doll looks to be about 12" or so tall when finished but not Barbie like. There are full sized patterns for a lady and slightly smaller girl doll, Victorian and more modern or character clothes, like a can-can dancer. The patterns easily lend themselves to Scarlet O'Hara or Little Women.The real treasure in this book are the diagrams for period furniture and accessories. It wouldn't take much to figure out how to add fasteners to the clothes so the doll can change them. The design would allow her to remain fully cloth. Most of the pages are patterns or diagrams with finished pictures of dolls and rooms or authentic Victorian fashion plates with clothes and hair styles. It's not quite a fashion history book but does a good enough job for the doll.2 of 2 people found
