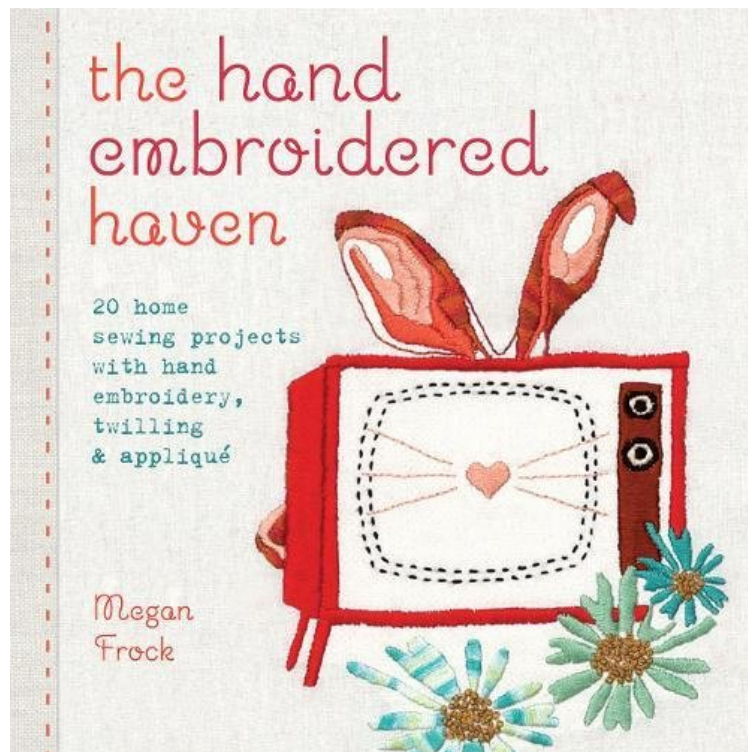

Megan Frocks basic stitches and techniques section is spot on, it is illustrated really well and is very clear and concise.The book covers hand embroidery, twilling, and appliqu. I had no idea what twilling was before I read this book, but I love the effect, it has such beautiful texture. I really look forward to trying it out.The embroidery patterns are amazing and really varied. There are sections for the living rooms and kitchen, adult bedrooms, nurseries, and older kid bedrooms. Despite the

wide range of project target ages, everything feels very connected. The baby projects feel just as modern and sophisticated as the ones for adults. You'll find projects for everything from kitchen towels to baby mobiles to robes. There's also some really gorgeous quilt patterns in the book which have a wonderful texture to them.
