Greenly's work is reviewed from all angles and brings his buoyant personality to life. Greenly's first book, "The Model Locomotive," was the first serious attempt to produce a textbook which placed the model steam engine on a firm basis whereby fundamental engineering principles and laws of mechanics were applied.
