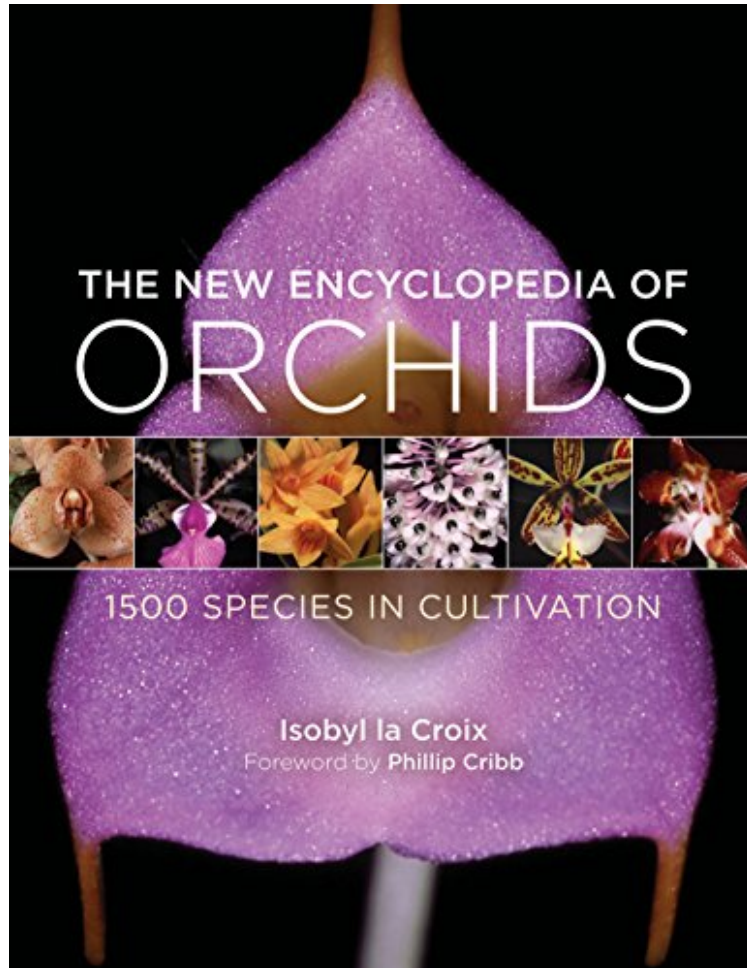

By escstanContent : This is a broad orchid species encyclopedia for all who has passion for orchids. Every orchid enthusiast should have one at home. This is a great reference material well illuminated, except it is not exhaustive in culture (like temperature, media for potting, water frequency etc.), it has only briefly indicated the species' habitat and altitude. For a novice like me, would need to do extra work on googling geographically to understand species habitat's culture. It would be best if author could add more pictures of the species in their natural habitat. Shipping : Very fast delivery in good conditions.
