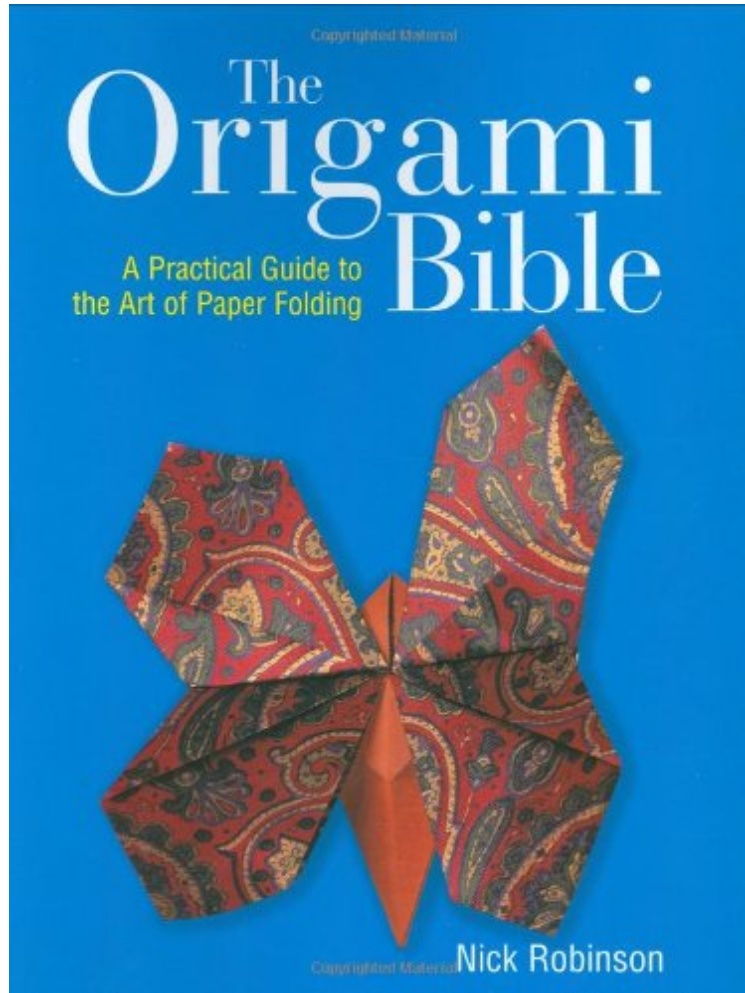

First of all it gives a nice short history of origami mentioning all the milestones, especially the importance of Lillian Oppenheimer in developing origami in USA. It follows with a discussion and diagrams of the basic folds giving special hints as to

how all the folds relate to each other. Suddenly you realise the logic of origami. Then it goes on to describe with very clear diagrams various animal, plant, mathematical, and artistic forms one can fold, as well as describing newer techniques such as paper wetting. As the reviewer above says, the book is not an in depth survey of all the origami creations you can fold, but it gives such a good grounding in origami, that those folds you thought were impossible....?
