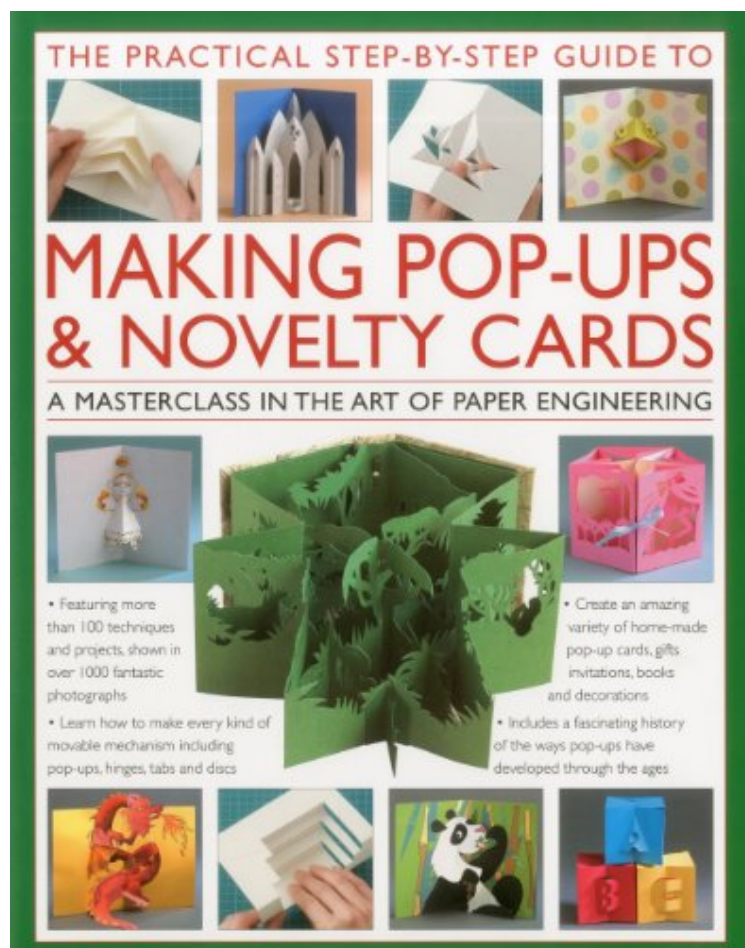

Each card builds upon the last card so each card or project is sequentially more challenging. I'd recommend for the beginner (like me) up to intermediate.
