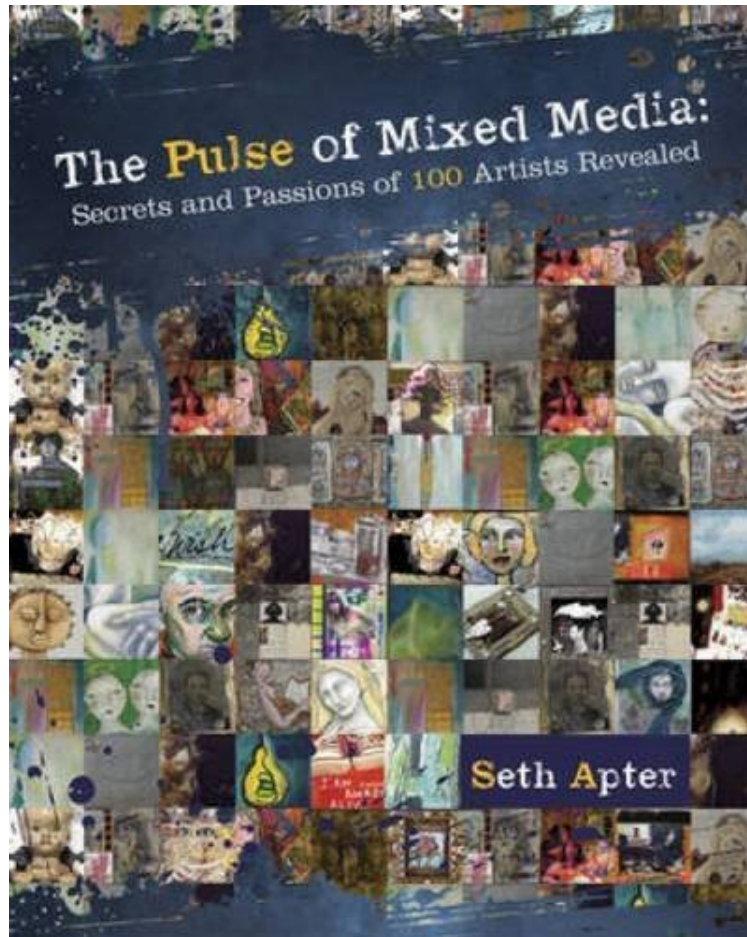

Seth Apter, New York City mixed media artist and psychologist (of famed mixed media blog The Altered Page), has brought together his considerable expertise in each of these fields to create "The Pulse of Mixed Media: Secrets and Passions of 100 Artist Revealed." This is NOT a 'how-to' book explaining or demonstrating mixed media arts techniques. There are many, many of that genre to be found in bookstores, already!
