This is the consummate reference book about trout fishing for trout fishermen, and it is written in an easy-to-read story-telling type style. One can easily learn by reading it for pleasure without even realizing you are gaining knowledge and insight. Some parts of the book are more instructive, especially regarding types of flies, fly patterns, and where and when they are most effective. Other parts can almost be viewed as historical relative to where Mr. Bergman was fishing and how he fared. Through it all, Mr. Bergman presents the information not as an expert, but as a fellow fisherman sharing what he has learned from his many years of fishing. He is a fly tying fisherman and wanted a book that showed how to tie a particular fly and what it should look like as a finished product. His original book from years ago had COLORED illustrations of the finished fly in it. The book I just received from had black and white pictures in it. The introduction in this book made reference to the beautiful COLORED illustrations, yet they were black and white. You can't tell from the pics in this book whether you have created a good fly or not. He was highly disappointed and I returned the book. My original request to was "Is this particular book a fluke or is this now how it is being printed?" My only response was that I could return the book if I was not satisfied.
