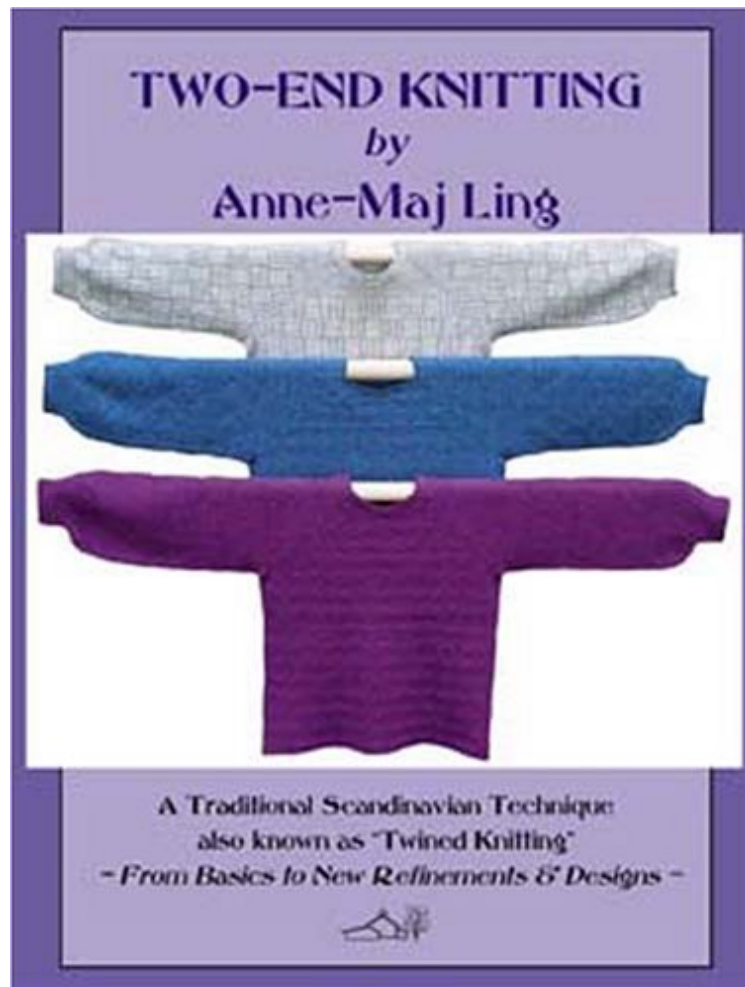

It seems simplistic in it's black and white format but it shows the traditional Dalarna method from basics to really refined patterns. The author describes quite clearly the methods she gathered throughout her knitting career. The patterns are linear, mosaic or hook or "krok" designs and included are great templates; some templates use all three methods together with up to three different colors. There is a great section on the hook stitch and on short rows at the back of the neck (a method used in Bohus yoke sweaters, another Swedish tradition). The mitten section is great too, showing gusset or traditional thumbs in single or double colors. So glad this book is back in print! I think there is

My suggestion is to start with "new Twists", then read this book if you want to know more.

The author has resurrected the ancient Scandinavian art of two-end knitting (also known as Tvebinding or twined knitting). The technique for creating the beautiful and distinctive garments she illustrates in this book (sweaters, jackets, skirts, mittens, vests, even a silk blouse) are thoroughly and clearly explained, from the basics to new refinements and designs.
