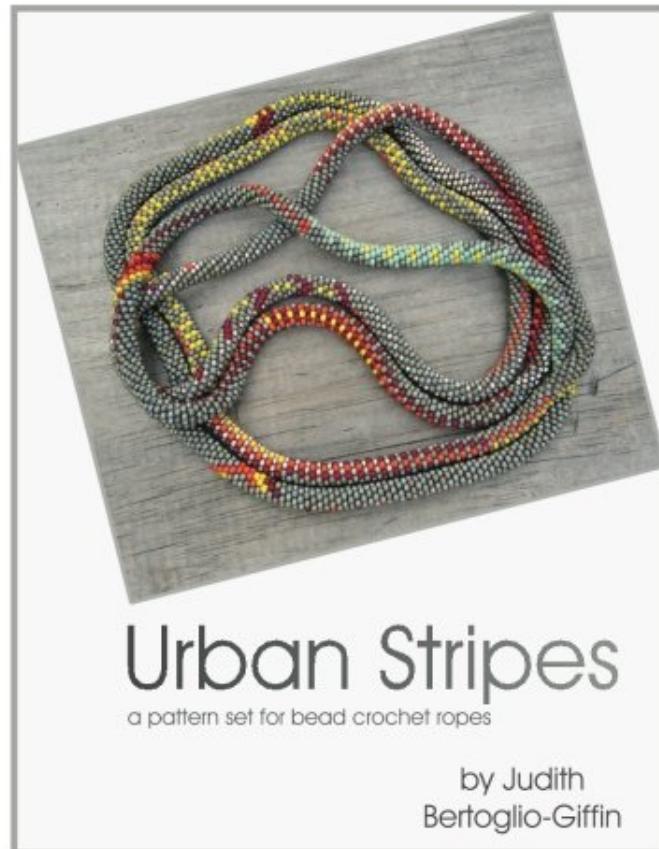

There are 4 complete projects to make if you just want to follow a pattern. Judith takes you a step further by providing 16 pattern sections and 48 repeat sections. The design possibilities are limitless. I was a participate online with the Urban Stripe project. I drew my color inspiration from boxcar graffiti. After completing the four patterns, I continued to pursue other color combinations mixing up sections to make each rope different and unique. This is a must have book for inspiration and design concepts in bead crocheted ropes.

This pattern set is the result of an on-line project. It's based on inspirations and colors culled from the urban landscape. There are multiple pattern sections that are strung, added to the previous section, and crocheted into 42" necklaces. Each pattern segment can be used alone, modified, or combined with other segments to build unique ropes. In this book, you will find: Urban color inspiration Design and construction tips. 4 complete projects 16 pattern sections 48 pattern repeats Blank graph paper to copy and use Adding in thread and invisible closure Just remember that this is a pattern set, not a big bulky bead crochet book. It can and will lead to a multitude of necklace combinations.
