Not to be bought on its own.By rickyA stunningly produced book full of large colour photographs with detailed instructions on techniques for making all sorts of items with patterns as listed in the contents page. However I am bitterly disappointed with the book and the accompanying CD.The CD files will not open. It says it has 60 designs for a piano shawl, but I have to take their word for it. Even the jpgs and the PDF will not open. Only by reading the instructions inside the book did I find out that this book is designed by a Pfaff embroidery machine user. My embroidery machine uses PES files but this is not one that is listed here so I cannot even view these lovely floral patterns. It may be that conversion software is available to change into my PES but it is not included here either. As I have opened the packaging for this disk I now cannot return the book and get my money back.I expected the book and CD to contain patterns for the fan and also the lace that is described and pictured. However it seems that I need to order another Pfaff CD 'Victorian Lace' which has the lace patterns. Again techniques described in yet another book by the author are used to produce gorgeous dyes on one of the fans pictured.I would only recommend this book to someone who loves looking at pictures of lovely Victorian things.
