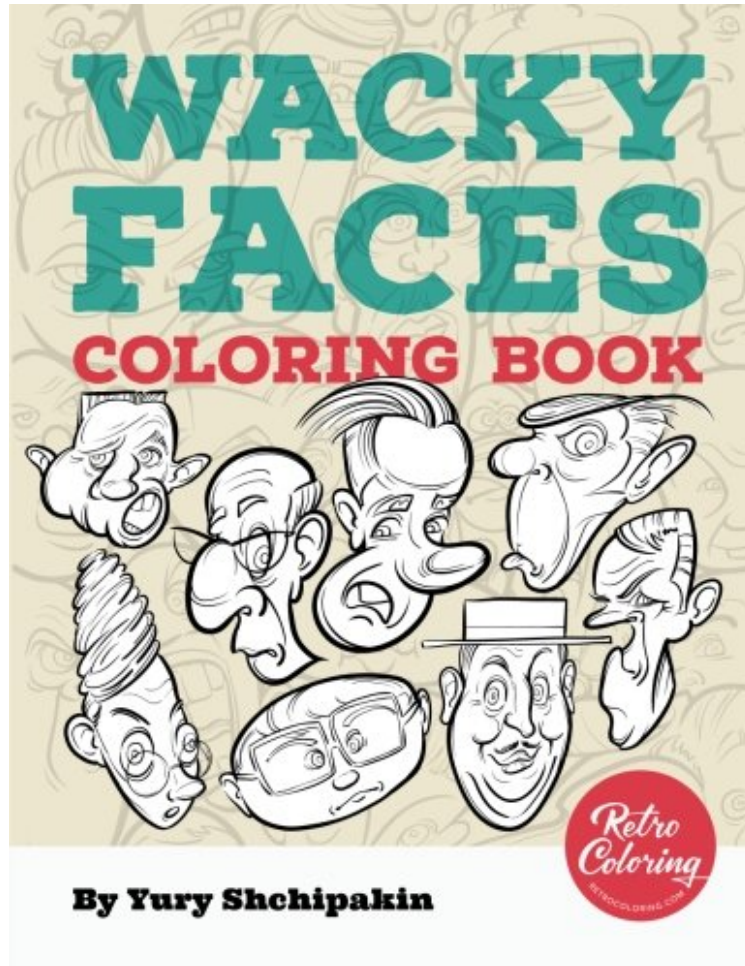

From the Back Cover Coloring Tips and Techniques Why limit yourself to basic technique only - bring your coloring to the next level of fun! Sketching Techniques Don't fill in solidly with just one color trying to keep within the lines - try various sketching drawing techniques for generating value and texture in your drawing. You shouldn't worry about making mistakes - let yourself enjoy the process. You can blend colors into one another and get a new tone or shade. Hatching Techniques Parallel hatching is one of the simplest method but it's still a very effective way to create the illusion of highlights and shadows. Contour hatching might work perfectly on cartoon images with curved contours. Fine crosshatching can create nuanced differences in tone and value - be sure your pencils are sharp enough for best results. Soft graphite pencils Why not use soft graphite pencil or mechanical pencil with softer darker leads and create some monochrome picture? Technically, it is not coloring - but who cares? There are no rules in art. Any mechanical pencil with 0.5 mm or 0.7 mm leads of 2B, 3B, 4B softness grade can give you so much joy that you might completely forget about colors! You can even try charcoal pencils or soft pastels. Watercolor You tried various pencils and techniques but why don't you just watercolor them? There are a wide variety of watercolor techniques that can be used on coloring pages - just to avoid using lot of water on thinner paper. Watercolor brush pens give amazing results. Think of yourself as an illustrator not as an coloring book fan - you are an artist!
