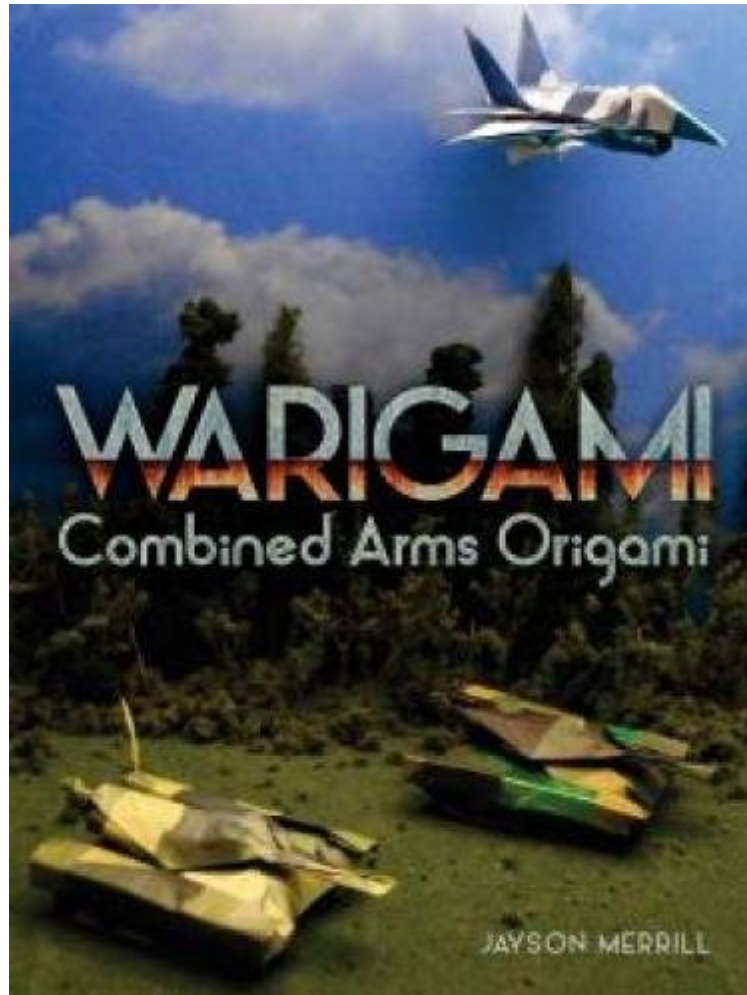

It's an interesting idea, but was not well executed. Even origami enthusiasts would have a little trouble with this. There are some intro folds in the beginning but the instructions are minimal and the diagrams aren't properly explained, its very easy to get lost in between steps. The "illustrated in full color, the step-by-step

instructions show how to assemble to models" are grey, so technically yes grey is a color. The suggestion of printing your own camo paper is not really practical, and finding somewhere to buy camo origami paper is near to impossible. The instructions average out to 20-37 steps, with some being over 50 steps to complete. To make this bearable the author needs to include a CD where there are instructional videos of each model, until then I would stay away from this item unless you want something that actively fights you. 1 of 2 people found the following review helpful. This is a definitely different take on origami! It starts by giving a guide to the key folds used to complete any of the models. The book then goes on to give instructions for creating models of a wide variety of war vehicles, including tanks, jets and missiles, all made using origami. It does suggest using foil as the base for making them and I suspect this is crucial to getting the more detailed folds and constructions completed accurately. There are annotated diagrams giving detailed step by step instructions, including how to fix the missiles to other models making them more fun to play with and not just models. Different sizes of base papers/foils are needed but the instructions make it clear just what will be needed to complete each one. Guidance is also provided on how to decorate the models to make them even more realistic and photographs of completed models are shared to inspire the reader to have a go! Whilst the instructions may be too complex for total beginners, they are very detailed and clear so, with patience and resilience, most reasonably dexterous readers should be able to complete them to a good standard. A definitely different book which will be of particular interest to anyone keen on war vehicles who is also willing to have a go at this craft. Thanks to the author, publishers and NetGalley, too, for letting me read an ARC of this book in exchange for an honest review.

Origami enthusiasts with a particular interest in weaponry will appreciate this unique book, which presents instructions for folding fourteen war machines: six jets, three missiles, and five ground vehicles. Illustrated in full color, the step-by-step directions show how to assemble the models. Origami aircraft include a spy plane, strike fighter, and bomber, plus impaler, javelin, and harpoon missiles that can be mounted on some of the jets. Models of ground vehicles include the predator battle tank and guardian battle walker.
